## Read Aloud Program History

The Read Aloud Program began in 1984 as a three-month pilot at one elementary school. In 1986, Charles Hill, then CEO of Westvaco Envelope Division, decided to provide the funding needed to expand the program citywide for students in grades K-4, as Westvaco's gift to Springfield, which was celebrating its 350th birthday. Jim Trelease, author of the best-selling Read Aloud Handbook, helped with the program design, and the program was wellreceived by schools and community members. Since then, with the support of generous funders, SSV has been able to expand Read Aloud to a five-month program serving students from pre-kindergarten through 5th grade.
